#### UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

#### For the 2019 class of first-year students, we saw:



**62%** more **first-generation** college students

#### 93% more **BIPOC students**

\*Data from 2019 incoming class of first-year students in our Elementary Education and Leadership and Community Engagement majors. Increases based on change from 2018 class.

#### **GRADUATE STUDENTS**

**33%** of all graduate students identify as **BIPOC** 

For the 2020 class of first-year students, we saw:

43% of MA students identify as BIPOC

42% of PhD students identify as BIPOC
